Becoming a Dementia Friendly Parish: On Monday 17 July 6:30pm-8:00pm we will be hosting a Dementia Information Session in the parish hall. The Dementia Friends team from LACE will lead the session, providing information and expertise on how we can become a Dementia Friendly Parish. In brief, Dementia is caused by diseases of the brain which can affect memory, everyday tasks, communication and perception. It is not a result of the normal ageing process. There are over 800,000 people living with dementia in the UK and this figure is set to rise. Churches and faith-based organisations have an important role to play in ensuring people living with dementia can continue to live their lives and be an active part of their communities for as long as possible. Many of our parishioners will develop dementia or be caring for someone who does. By being more dementia friendly, we can help and support them to continue practicing their faith. Please do come along on 17 July so that we can raise our awareness and work together in becoming a **'Dementia Friendly Parish'**. The session is open to all parishioners, our schools and neighbouring churches. Parish groups including Eucharistic ministers who provide home visits, bereavement groups, SVP, UCM and RYM are particularly encouraged to attend.
